**1. PRE-SERVICE TEACHER EDUCATION**

**1.1. PRE-SERVICE STUDENT TEACHERS ENROLMENT RESULT**

**One of the main function of DIETs is Pre-service Teacher Education and the Institute runs 2 Year Pre-service Diploma in Elementary Education ( D.El. Ed) Certificate course. The intake capacity of DIETs across the State is 50 annually.**
